

SECRETS OF SANTA FE APRIL 27-MAY 1, 2026

Day 1 April 27, 2026

We will depart Lake Havasu City via deluxe motorcoach to make our way to the Petrified Forest National Park with a lunch stop in Flagstaff. Colorful remnants of petrified logs decorate this National Park that stretches for miles in every direction. We'll stop at the Painted Desert Visitor Center to learn more about the park's peculiar rocks. We will then make our way to Gallup, NM for dinner and overnight accommodations. (L,D)

Day 2 April 28, 2026

After breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for Santa Fe, NM. After an included lunch, a local guide will join us for a sightseeing tour of Santa Fe. We will spend the rest of the afternoon at the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum. The Museum is the home of over 3,000 works comprised of 140 O'Keeffe oil paintings, nearly 700 drawings, and hundreds of additional works dating from 1901 to 1984. We will then have dinner in Santa Fe and check into Drury Plaza Hotel Santa Fe for 2 nights. (B,L,D)

Day 3 April 29, 2026

We will enjoy a breakfast buffet at the hotel before departing for Los Alamos. We will spend the morning at The Bradbury Science Museum, which is the chief public facility of Los Alamos National Laboratory. You will see more than 40 interactive exhibits in the Museum's three galleries. After an included lunch, we will visit the School for Advanced Research which showcases creative research in Native American arts, anthropology, and related disciplines. We'll end our evening at El Flamenco Cabaret Dinner Show featuring traditional Spanish dance and music. (B,L,D)

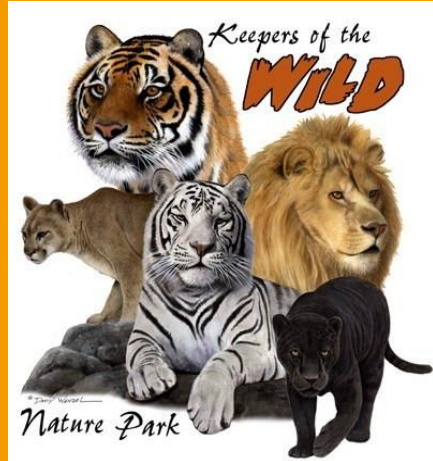

Day 4 April 30, 2026

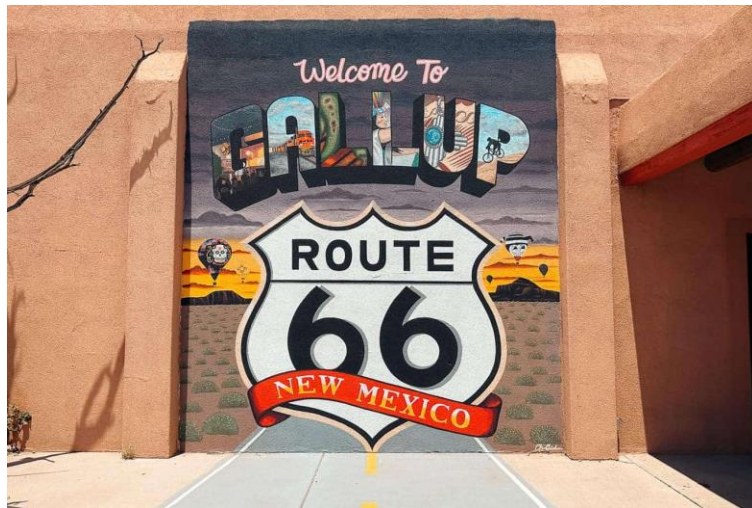
